
My apologies that this information was not shared with you before the holidays but unfortunately I was unable to do this due to circumstances beyond my control.

### **Session times**

Our gates open at 8:40 am so that our school day starts promptly at 8.50am. School finishes at 3.20pm.

We would like to remind you of the importance of attendance and punctuality and ask that you make every effort to bring your child to school every day and collect them on time. If you are late in the morning you will need to go to the front desk at Reception where the admin staff will see you. Please telephone the school in the morning if your child is going to be absent from school.

### Medical

If your child is asthmatic please could you ensure that they have an in date inhaler, labelled with their name, in school at all times! It is also important that school have a



copy of their care plan too – thank you for your cooperation.

Children should not bring in any medicine into school without registering it at the school office and speaking with a first aider.
