Apples & Pears


- Please encourage children to put on and take off their coats and shoes by themselves.

- Library bags will be sent home on a Wednesday and should be brought to school by the following Monday.


Apples & Pears

Our topic for the remainder of this half term is **People Who Help Us**. We will be introducing books that are about people who help us and what they do e.g Doctors, Police, Firefighters and Nurses. We will start with a book called 'First Time Doctor', the children will be learning how these people help us. We will also be doing many activities around this topic. In maths we will be encouraging the children to count 1-10 and to recognise numbers in the environment. We will also be working on developing the children's understanding of prepositions e.g in, around, over, behind, beside, in front and under. We will continue to help the children with their cutting skills which will develop their hand and eye coordination. The children will also have the opportunity to extend their vocabulary through songs, stories and small group work. Please reinforce our learning at home. If you have anything of interest that may help with the children's learning then please share this with the Nursery team. Thank you.



Cherries

For the remainder of this half term our topic is **How Do We Get There?** Our learning will be based around the following books: Naughty Bus and Lost and Found. We will be working with the children to identify the similarities and differences between different types of transport. We will also be encouraging the children to draw and use maps for their own naughty bus. During our topic we will be taking the children out in the local area to look for cars, buses, trucks and trains. Through the story of Lost and Found the children will make boats using different materials and test them to see if they sink or float. We will also work with the children to compare the South Pole to where we live and recognise the different emotions in the story. Please reinforce our learning at home. If you have anything of interest that may help with the children's learning then please share this with the Nursery team. Thank you.
