



## Here is a guide to children's individual attendance

 <p>Green</p>	<p>Attendance above 95%</p> <p>Well done – keep up the good work! <b>Children do their best learning if their attendance at the end of the year has been 96% or over.</b></p>
 <p>Yellow</p>	<p>Attendance between 90% and 95%</p> <p>This might be because they have had an illness this winter, although unfortunately for some of our families it is because they have extended the length of their school holiday.</p> <p>It is especially important that your child comes to school every day for the rest of the school year (unless they are too ill) so that their attendance at the end of the year is up to that important <b>96% or over.</b></p>
 <p>Red</p>	<p>Attendance below 90%</p> <p>The number of absences your child has had may be having an impact on their learning. We understand that in some cases this is because of illness or medical treatment and there will be a note of that on your register. However, if your child's attendance is this low, we need you to work with us to improve it by the end of the school year.</p>

Please give your child their best chance to learn by helping us to improve attendance. Remember, you should not book travel which takes your child out of school during term time, even if it is near to a school holiday. If you make medical appointments, try to make them for the end of the day or the school holiday or avoid them missing a whole day. Children are learning every day at Parkfield!
