



# Childcare for 2yr olds available from September at Parkfield Primary School



How do I know if my 2-year-old is eligible for 15 hours free provision ?

Your 2-year-old child may be able to get a free place if you have an annual household income of under £16,190 (before tax) and either receive certain non-working benefits or receive working tax credit or your child receives Disability Living Allowance (DLA)

Places are also available if:

Your child has a current Statement of Special Educational Needs (SEN) or an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP); or

You have adopted your child or you have a special guardianship order or residence order to care for them or

A child is looked after by the Local Authority, for example, they are in foster care.

There will be an opportunity for Parents who are not entitled to free sessions to pay for provision at an additional cost.

If you meet any of these three criteria, you will need to have paper proof of this to claim your child's free place.
