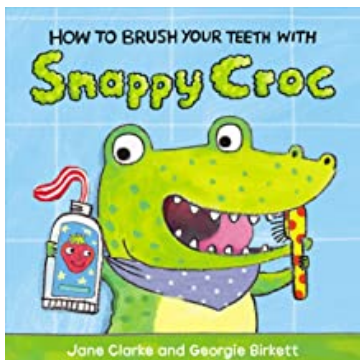
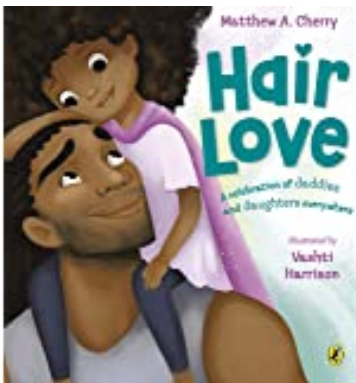

Our topic this half-term

Looking After Me

We are learning to look after our bodies and our minds.

Some books we will use are:



Art: Art week this year will focus on colour mixing, layering, textures. Martin O'Neill is the artist Year one will use as inspiration for our final art pieces.

PHSE: We are learning about the different ways we keep ourselves clean and healthy.

Maths: We are learning the place value of numbers from 0-10.

English: We are learning to use full stops, capital letters and finger spaces in our writing. We will create an acrostic poem, a passport about ourselves and write instructions.

Religious Education: We are learning about faith leaders in our community.

PE: We will learn about running, jumping and throwing and how to move objects while we are moving.

History: Black History Month: We are learning about how the achievements and recent events of black communities affect us.
