To deepen our experience, we will be going to the Gillian Lynne theatre in London to see the live performance of the story!

Our trip is on the 16th of November. It is a matinee performance so we will be back to school about 6:30pm.



# What we will be learning

We will be exploring the classical story of The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe by C.S.Lewis. We will be using drama and the theatre experience to help us create our own stop puppets for our own stop-motion animation.

D&T - In Design and Technology, we will be learning about textiles and sewing. We will design and make our own finger puppets, as well as a set design, which will be used to recreate a scene from The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe.

Maths - In maths we will be focussing on multiplication and division. This includes common multiples and factors and formal methods of calculations including long multiplication and long division. We will also use this knowledge to convert units.

English - In English we will learn how to use imagery to write more interesting and detailed poems and narratives. We will also write a play script which we will perform with our puppets.

Geography - In Geography, we will investigate a range of animal habitats and describe the key aspects of biomes and vegetation belts. We will think about how and why countries around the world are changing.
