Our topic this half-term:

<u>Tudors -</u> <u>Tradition</u> & Treason

We will be exploring the life and court of King Henry VIII. This will include learning about his life and the hierarchy of his court and the treacherous and dangerous times living under his rule. Additionally, we will also learn about the lasting impact the Tudors have had on modern day Britain.

To support our learning and deepen our experience we will be reading Treason by Berlie Doherty

What we will be learning

Maths - In maths, we will be focussing on numbers to 10 million, place value. This will include reading, writing, ordering and comparing numbers.

English - In English we are using Treason to help us write historical narratives. We will also use our historical knowledge to write an information text.

History - We will be aiming to answer some key questions about the Tudors through our learning e.g. Do I know about life in Tudor England? Why was the Battle of Bosworth important? How was the Tudor court organised?

Science - In Science, we will be learning about light. What a ray of light is and how it travels. We will be able to explain the effect of lenses.

RE - To understand and discuss why faith may be important to an individual and how this may be expressed. To look at the impact that the Reformation would have had on people at the time.

Key Topic Vocabulary

- come up with an action or movement that represents the word
- Use the word in a sentence (model correct use and pronunciation)
- Create an acrostic poem or song about the word
- Draw a picture that represents the definition of the word
- Find other words that mean the same
