Be resilient!

- Keep trying even when you get stuck, or leave what you are stuck on but come back to it later.
- Complete **all of the work** your teacher leaves for you - not just the one you think is easiest
- Make sure you do your best work, not just your quickest work. You should be as proud of your online work as you are of your school books. We will notice if you hand in a piece of work you have not finished or that you rushed through. We will also notice when you do your very best.



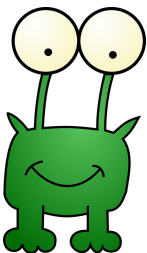
Be reflective!

- Think about where you learn best - are you comfortable? No distractions?
- Think about how to make yourself feel like you are at school while you work - Maybe wear your school uniform while you are working and change when you finish Plan out your day so that you can finish all your tasks between 9.30 and 3.00 - don't forget to plan in breaks!
- Think about the treat you will have when you finish your work - maybe a game or some TV, *but not until all your work is finished* - you will be so proud!



Be reciprocal!

- **Join in with the classroom stream every day. That is when you can leave comments for your friends and teachers and get answers straight away.**
- Leave comments with your work at other times if you are stuck or just proud, the teachers will answer as quickly as they can.
- Read the comments your teachers leave.
- Encourage your friends or share with the class if you have a good idea.
- If you have brothers and sisters who are doing school work too - be kind! Help them, share devices, don't distract them if it is their turn to work.
- Be really kind to the adults helping you - they are having a very busy time at the moment and they are not experts on school work like you are.



Be resourceful!

- If you are stuck - remember things you have learnt in class, they could help!
- Make sure you have any equipment you need before you start working.
- If you don't have the same equipment the teacher has, be creative and use something else.

Most importantly - have fun and do your best to complete all your work in a way you can be proud of. I am really proud of you and I can't wait for us all to be together in school again so that we can celebrate all of your hard work.
